Joey also helps with the sponsored school children, delivering and collecting letters from and to sponsors, and ensuring the children and the families are ok.

Fayette and some helpers are running the feeding program in Ipel, Lawis, Baglis and Mucabug (the rubbish dump)

Joey and Fayette have a team who will prepare the children for this coming years school sponsorship by buying school requirements and paying school fees





Ormoc

In Ormoc we have 86 sponsored children in school with 2 now in college.

The Christmas party was a huge success as the team lead by Joey and his wife were able to prepare and serve over 150 children along with, I believe over 50 parents. A job well done to our dedicated team.

Food hampers were prepared and given out to all the sponsored children's families a total of 75 in all. .

This year we needed to hire a venue as the community centre has not been completed at this stage as we have focussed on the building of the families homes first. This last week the building team have started to either rebuild or renovate 26 homes of the sponsored children's families. This when completed will be all of the sponsored children's family homes completed. At the moment the two building teams are building a home every few days from start to finish. A job very well done.

As for the school sponsorship this year we are looking to increase the number of children going to school our goal in all 4 cities both in the Philippines and in India will be 200 children going to school.

Maasin

In Maasin Destiny Inc has 4 feeding sites and now a school feeding program.

The feedings sites are helping around 140-170 children a week with some of the parents around 35 per week. These sites are organized by two young ladies in Joy Lorezo and Faith Lorezo, whose father is our leader along with his wife in Maasin. About August last year 2014 they started to run a school lunch time feeding program, feeding approximately 350 children and some of the parents who come to help with the cooking and serving of the meal.

This years' Christmas party although it was raining heavily seen 130 children plus their parents come to enjoy the festivities.

Further to the christmas party we were able to provide Christmas food hampers to all the families of the 36 sponsored children. Destiny would like to thank all those who connected with us to be able to provide the hampers.

It is amazing to see how far \$20 will go when given in the right area.

We are looking to increase the school sponsorship from 36 children to 50children this coming school year. School starts in the first week of June 2015.

India

These Children desperately need sponsors, They come from the very poorest of areas and have no hope of breaking the cycle of poverty they are trapped in



Adelaide

This year was a very exciting year as we were able to distribute 25 hams across Adelaide from Elizabeth in the North to Henley Beach in the South to Ingle Farm in the East, In conjunction with these hams we were able to distribute 8 food hampers valued in excess of \$100.

Distribution of food parcels is continuous throughout the year in and around Adelaide.

Last year Destiny has also helped single parents to move house, and help them get settled, this is also an ongoing activity.

Once again we would like to give heartfelt thanks to the wonderful people at North Haven Pharmacy, for their ongoing support through the year.


Through their warm hearted generosity we have seen an extra 7 children sponsored.

Something to be aware of

Destiny would like to address the facebook situation.

As we have no control over who goes on facebook, we are obligated to inform you of the potential of abuse of our sponsors generosity.

We do not embrace the children contacting their sponsors as this can lead to others around the children to friend the sponsor.

The reason for us taking this stand is to firstly protect your children, from possible exploitation. Once anything goes on face book the information as in address and other private info becomes available to the world.

Secondly there is the protection for our sponsors who are very generous people, but if they are being asked for money they will feel abused and drop their sponsorship for that child.

This will then bring the ministry into a loss of integrity and the decline of help for the sponsored children.

As Sponsors, Destiny would like you to be aware that it is unlikely that requests for money or for help in other areas will come from the sponsored child but from their extended family.

Once again I say that we cannot stop this kind of thing but we must let you know our position on this.

We cannot take any responsibility for any thing or for anyone who gets hurt in this area of communication.
