Meeting with the Lord Mayor of Ormoc City, who was very interested in the work Destiny Inc. does in his city. We have invited him to attend a feeding program and the handing out of school supplies in 2017.

We also held the first of our Married Couples Seminars where we spoke about commitment in marriage with great results.

While in Ormoc City we had our first Team Destiny leaders meeting where we shared Destiny Inc's vision and direction for the coming years.

Maasin

Attended a seniors feeding program of approx 60 seniors where we had our trainee nurse take the blood pressure of the seniors. We visited Maria Clara Elementary school where Destiny is going to complete the building of the change rooms and toilet block for 350 children, and also visited sponsored children's homes and as a result Destiny is repairing six houses that badly needed help.

Tacloban

Met with the Mayor's assistant who has a great appetite to help Destiny in its work helping children.

Held our second Marriage Seminar, a 3 day Seminar and a Family Day and partnered with a local Pastor to hold a open air meeting where we spoke on hope and vision after Typhoon Yolanda.
